Knowingly furnishing false information for the purpose of obtaining emergency and other involuntary admission for any person is a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in F.S. 775.082 and by a fine not exceeding \$5,000.00.

Causing or otherwise securing, or conspiring with or assisting another to cause or secure, without reason for believing a person to be impaired, any emergency or other involuntary procedure for the person, is a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in F.S. 775.082 and by a fine not exceeding \$5,000.00.
